WHAT? What information is being communicated? What is this source's main idea? What event/person/theme is this source about?	
Does this source raise any further questions for you?	
WHO?	
Who are the main people mentioned in the source? Include information such as titles and birth dates or death dates when available	
WHEN?  When do the events take place?  What range of time does the source cover?	
WHERE?  Where do the events take place?  Include information such as city, country, town, etc.	
WHY?  Why is the event or person significant?  Does the source answer the question "so what?" regarding the importance of the person or event covered?

**BIAS:** prejudice or favour against or for a thing, group or person. Usually considered to be unfair.
