- 1. Describe Sam Steele's personality, according to the people who speak about him in the movie. What kind of public recognition does Sam have today?
- 2. What stood in the way of Sam's ambitions to command the North West Mounted Police?
- 3. What part of Canada most fascinated Sam? Why?
- 4. Provide an example of Sam's negotiation skills.
- 5. What components of the traditional Mountie uniform were pioneered by Sam?
- 6. Who was Sam's wife? Who was her father? When did Sam meet her? How many children did they have?
- 7. What circumstances lead Sam to threaten a group of strikers with his gun?
- 8. How were criminals punished when Sam was in charge of Dawson City?
- 9. How did Sam react when he discovered that Chief Isadore's lands had been "sold" to a British immigrant?
- 10. How and when did Sam die? What does his great-grandniece say was the cause of his death?
- 11. Sam once wrote: "I had the lone land before me, where it's a man own fault if he fails while he has health and strength." Based on what you've learned about Sam from the film, what do you think he meant by this?
