As part of the program, we have created The Citizenship Challenge Collection - your go-to space for:

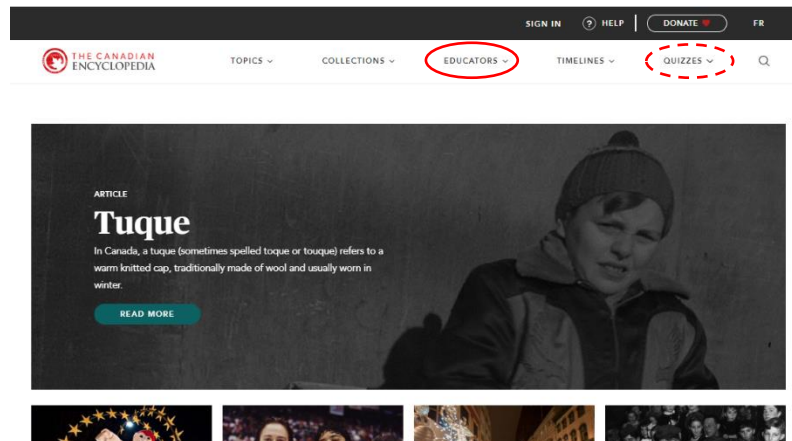
- Educational tools and quizzes relating to Canadian history and civics, and,
